The Masonic Motorcycle Club has basically done all of the organizational work you will need to get started. Your main concern will be to get enough interested brothers to form a local chapter.

Chapter #1 was started in May of 1982 with only 10 Master Mason present at the first get together. It has now grown to over 100 members. We credit this growth to the mutual interest of motorcycling and to the good friendship that the Masons, their wives, and family find when joining together in an activity such as this. When this same interest was shown in other parts of the state and country, it was decided to form the Masonic Motorcycle Club International. This was done in April 1984. The International is now the parent organization over all the chapters and is responsible for governing and the growth of local chapters in various areas.

When you decide to start a chapter and pay the initiation fee of \$100.00, you will be furnished a packet containing copies of the International Club bylaws, Constitution and Resolutions. Riding procedures with safety information and materials on how to organize and run your local chapter are also included. After you become chartered, you will be entitled to all rights and benefits of the Masonic Motorcycle Club International and at that point be entitled to wear our club emblem, which is a registered trademark, and we are sure you'll agree it's quite unique.

Enclosed is a brochure titled "The Masonic Motorcycle Club International and You". Also a copy of our last International Newsletter is enclosed. Study this information and follow the instructions.

No fee is required until you finally decide to start this endeavor.

We know that once your chapter gets off the ground, you will meet and gain new Masonic friends. You will also have a sense of pride in belonging to a motorcycle club that is not only respected in the community, but one that you and your family will enjoy traveling with for many pleasurable miles.
